Notice of Town Meeting,

Notice is hereby given that the first town meeting in the Town of Canosia, in County of St. Louis, State of Missouri, organized on the 3rd day of February 1888, by the board of County Commissioners of said St. Louis County, will be held at the School House, in School District number ten (No. 10) in said county organized Town of Canosia, on Thursday, the 23rd day of February 1888, from 9 o'clock in the forenoon to 5 o'clock in the afternoon, for the purpose of electing officers for said town of Canosia, and also for the purpose of transacting any other lawful business. There shall be elected at said town meeting three (3) Representatives, one of which shall be designated in the ballot as chairman, one (1) Town Clerk, one (1) Treasurer, one (1) Assessor, two (2) Justices of the Peace, two (2) Constables and such other officers as are required by law to be chosen.
